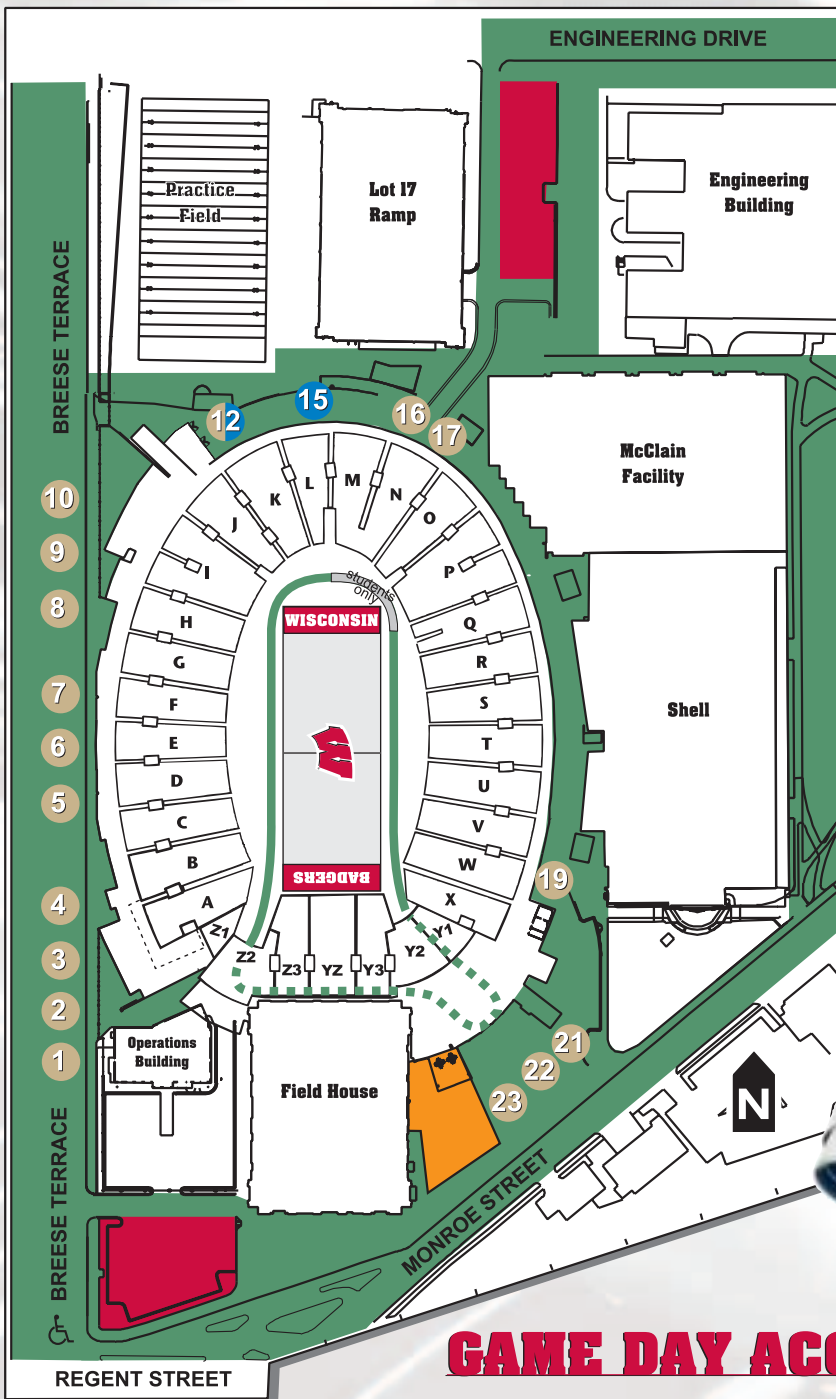


2004 GAME DAY STADIUM ACCESS

GAME DAY ACCESS TIPS

- It is very important to allow extra time to enter Camp Randall Stadium. Gates open 90 minutes prior to kickoff.
- For everyone's safety, it is extremely important that you use the stadium entrance printed on your ticket.
- Please observe special informational signs and the instructions of your section usher to assist with entering and exiting the stadium.
- Students are encouraged to approach the stadium from the north end and use either Gate 15 or the east half of Gate 12. Gate 16 will NOT serve as a student entrance in 2004.

Stadium Access: All entrance gates to the stadium will be accessible during the 2004 season. Several gates on the eastside have been reconfigured to enclose the eastside fire lane within the confines of the stadium.

Elevator Access and Control: New elevators on the east side of the stadium will be designated by elevator for suite and club seat area use and for patrons with ADA needs. Please contact Guest Services or the Wisconsin Athletic Ticket Office if you have a special need that requires use of an elevator.
